

*We want you to feel comfortable for your engagement session so that your photos reflect the real you. My first piece of advice would be to wear something that you feel you look HOT in. If you don't feel hot in it.. then the photos will show it. So be hot! Same goes with your significant other. You should help them pick something out but make sure they feel attractive in it as well!*

**What not to wear:**

- Heavy Patterns
- Stripes
- One single color outfits
- Tank Tops/Tube Tops
- Bermuda Shorts

**\*\*\*Shirt tip for women\*\*\*** - The shorter the sleeve the more of your arm that is exposed in the photograph. So if you aren't comfortable with the way your arms look in photographs I would recommend a 3/4 link shirt. I'll show you the difference using the same outfit. The reason I suggest a 3/4 link shirt over a short sleeve shirt if you have this problem is because a short sleeve shirt often times cuts into the upper portion of the arm drawing more attention to the problem area. If you have no idea what I'm talking about with the arm issue then you are one of the lucky ones that don't have this problem. So JUMP for joy and be lucky you can wear a short sleeve shirt!

- Skirts {If you absolutely must that is ok! We just say this because we often times ask you to sit on the ground/grass/floor in our poses .} So if you do decide to wear a skirt sit down and make sure you can move without it being a problem! :)

How to look HOT:

Select a color that is appropriate for the season. I'm more prone to bright colors because in photos the bright colors POP and you'll love them.

If you go for a dark colored sweater/shirt , brighten it up with a chunky colorful necklace or scarf.

Well-fitted jeans always look awesome. If you opt for jeans, both people should wear jeans.

If you are comfortable in heels I would definitely suggest them. Having heels or stilettos on when posing make you look slimmer. If you aren't comfy in heels go for some cool looking flats! I definitely wouldn't recommend casual plain flip flops.

Layers look awesome. Don't make them too bulky though.

If your session is in the winter, I would suggest a cute coat with bright accessories. Also make sure to wear some clothes underneath (sweater and what not) that you feel attractive in as well.

If one person wears shorts the other person should wear something complimentary such as capris or a sundress.

I find that dressing up always looks better in photos rather than the casual approach, if you would like both types of looks. Bring a change of clothes that are easy to change into.

\*\*\*TIP FOR MEN\*\*\*

If your man tends to be on the hairy side have him stick to pants and remind him to wear an undershirt under whatever shirt he decides on.

Don't worry about locations. If you have a place that you guys like to go, fabulous let me know and we can go there. Your engagement session is about your personality so however we can get that into the photos we are totally up for it! If you can't think of anything, no problemo! We have many locations throughout Indiana that will be perfect for you!

Things to note for the e-session day:

Try not to bring a lot of bags. If you have your purse I would lock it up in the trunk of the car. That frees up the assistant/2nd photographer to be able to shoot more photos of you. If you need to bring a lipstick/gloss, feel free to bring that and a compact and we can keep it in our bags.

Please let me know beforehand if there are any health conditions I should be made aware of that might affect the way I pose. Things like if it's hard for you to sit on the ground or walk up/down stairs.

Most importantly relax because we are going to have some serious fun!
